The CDC's *Healthy People 2030* identifies annual adverse drug events (ADEs) or harm resulting from medication error has generated 1.3 million emergency department (ED) encounters, 350,000 hospitalizations and accounts for over \$3.5 billion in excess medical costs. This report considers ADEs a serious public health problem, with most being preventable.

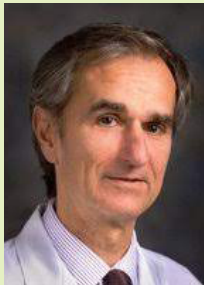
